PROJECTS & UPDATES

Journey to Belonging (J2B)

The Ministry continues to explore and test individualized budget models that may be used with the J2B implementation. CLNP is starting to test purchased service models that will align with the Ministry's directions.

Teaching Kitchen

CLNP has received funding from Service Canada to improve accessibility at our office at 820 Main St East. Funds will be used to improve accessible doors throughout the building and to renovate the kitchen for improved accessibility for teaching activities.

Architect Design Underway

We are excited to announce that the design of our Bring Us Home building has begun! We are using the input provided by Voices on the Horizon (Self Advocates) to guide our plan.

Libro Grant Received

With this grant we will introduce a program that teaches basic money skills. It will build confidence and independence in everyday money tasks like paying bills, shopping, saving, and making informed choices.

Human Resources Improvements

We are at the conclusion of a 2-year Resiliency Grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation. We have improved our hiring, onboarding, and training outcomes. We have also been able to build efficiencies into our scheduling and payroll systems.

Accessibility at SGL Residence

We are planning an accessibility upgrade at one of our supported group living residences. The duplex will have a new connecting front porch, complete with an accessible ramp.
